

2. San Juan International Airport (SJO)

The Juan Santamaría International Airport (SJO) is located on the outer fringe of San Jose, Costa Rica. The airport has gone through plenty of improvements over the past few years and is renovated regularly to keep up with the increasing growth rate of the economy. Free WiFi is provided for your convenience, but do not rely on it! Plan on getting an international roaming service through your mobile service provider. There are also ATM machines located in the baggage claim area so you can draw cash to enable paying for services during your visit.

Airport Arrival Procedures

- On Aircraft. You will receive a customs form on your flight to Costa Rica. That form does
 not go to the immigration officer (the officer stamping your passport), but to the agent at
 the baggage scanner after you pickup your bags at baggage claim you will hand him
 the form before putting your luggage on the baggage scanner
 - o Ensure your custom form is completed prior to landing
 - Annotate "Dominical" in the Address Block on the custom form for your Costa Rica destination address. Exact address is normally not required.
- Debark Aircraft
- Pass through Immigration Desk.
 - Follow the signs to Immigration checkpoints to get your passport stamped.
 - o Ensure Customs paper is completed
 - Proceed through Immigration checkpoint
 - Proceed to Baggage claim
- Procure baggage
- Proceed to customs
 - o Provide customs form to attendant
 - Place luggage on xray
- Pass through customs to Terminal Exit





Departing the Airport

- After going through customs, proceed to the airport exit
- Take either a taxi of UBer to Tracopa Bus Terminal
